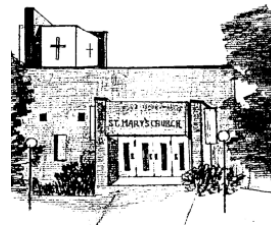
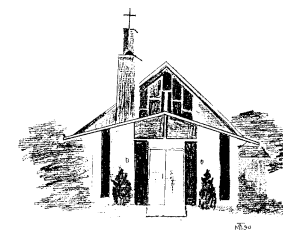

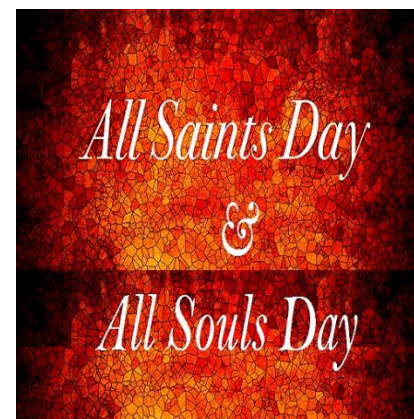

If a cemetery undertaker or care taker is doing the burial, it will not be in the parish record. It's applicable not only for us, but for all the parishes of the Archdiocese.

This is the day that the Church celebrates all those people who have died and gone through their purification (either in this world or in Purgatory) and are in the Presence of the Lord.
