**All Souls Day Remembrance:** We will remember and pray for all our dear deceased ones from the parish and our families on all souls day and throughout November. We have no access to the record of the people who had no Catholic funeral/burial even if they are a long-time parishioner. Friends, when you prepare your wills, please make sure that you will get a Catholic funeral/burial or a least a grave side prayer and blessing of the grave. If a cemetery undertaker or care taker is doing the burial, it will not be in the parish record. It's applicable not only for us, but for all the parishes of the Archdiocese.
