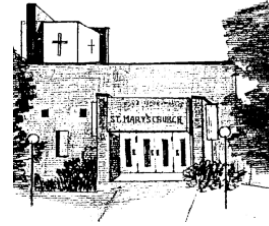
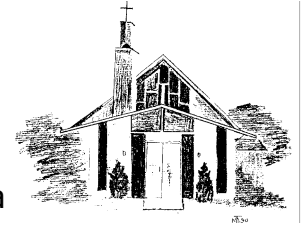

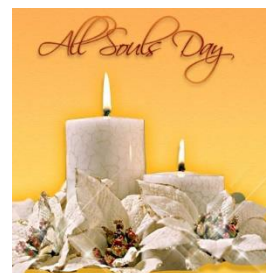
All Friday Masses will be at 3 pm followed by Exposition and Adoration

All Souls Day Remembrance: We will remember and pray
for all our dear deceased ones from the parish and our families
on all souls day and throughout November. The Saturday
following the all-souls day we will have a Mass offered for them
and a candle lit by a family member for those passed away in
the current year. In 2023 it will be on Sat Nov 4, at 5 pm for
those deceased from Nov 2, 2022 to November 4, 2023.

The names of the deceased are taken from the parish register. We have no access
to the record of the people who had no Catholic funeral/burial even if they are a long-
time parishioner. Friends, when you prepare your wills, please make sure that you
will get a Catholic funeral/burial or a least a grave side prayer and blessing of the
grave. If a cemetery undertaker or care taker is doing the burial, it will not be in the
parish record. It's applicable not only for us, but for all the parishes of the
Archdiocese.

Prayers for the Departed Souls During November you may place your prayers
for your departed loved-one in the Remembrance Book and these departed Souls will
be prayed for during Mass. Instead of writing "the family of" please list all the
individual names.

Cemetery Collection: November 19 will be the annual collection for St. Mary's
