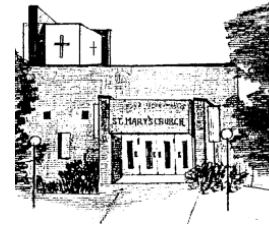
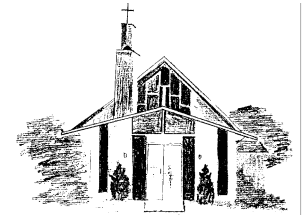

Fast and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday Day of Fast and Abstinence for Catholics

- Fasts? Those 18 - 59 years old. one regular and two small meals.
Abstains? Those 14 years old until death.
Abstinence means from your principal food. For 99.9% of people, this
ordinally means MEAT.
Exceptions? Those truly ill are excused from fasting, but not from abstinence.
Parents: Even though your children may be under the age limit, it doesn't hurt
them to do some type of fasting and even abstinence.
