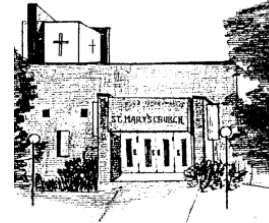
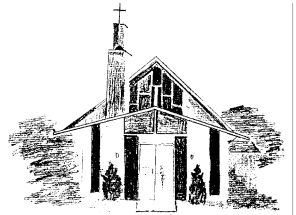

**Anointing of the Sick:** The Sacrament of Anointing is given on request, especially before going to the hospital, or at the hospital or at home.

### Archbishop Mulhall's Spiritual Conferences at St. Mary's Cathedral

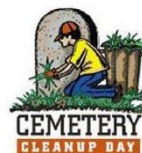
