Marriage: 9–12 months notice is needed for the celebration of the Sacrament of Matrimony. Each couple is required to participate in a Marriage Preparation course.

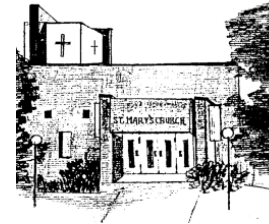
Reconciliation: Confessions heard from 4:00-4:45 pm on Sat or by appointment.

Anointing of the Sick: The Sacrament of Anointing is given on request, especially before going to the hospital, or at the hospital or at home.

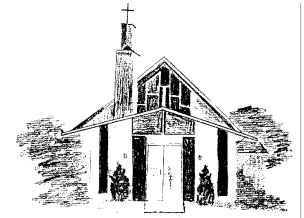
Sick List: Please call the office if anyone needs prayers, a visit or is seriously ill.

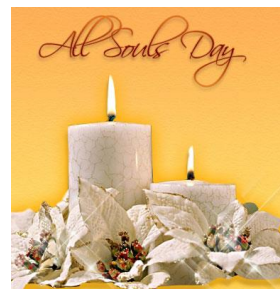

All Souls Day Remembrance: We will remember and pray for all our dear deceased ones from the parish and our families on all souls day and throughout November. The Saturday following the all-souls day we will have a Mass offered for them and a candle lit by a family member for those passed away in the current year. In 2024 it will be on Saturday November 2, at 5 pm for those deceased from Nov 2, 2023 to Nov 2, 2024.

The names of the deceased are taken from the parish register.

We have no access to the record of the people who had no Catholic funeral/burial even if they are a long-time parishioner. Friends, when you prepare your wills, please make sure that you will get a Catholic funeral/burial or a least a grave side prayer and blessing of the grave. If a cemetery undertaker or care taker is doing the burial, it will not be in the parish record. It's applicable not only for us, but for all the parishes of the Archdiocese.

All Saints Day Friday, 01 November. This is the day that the Church celebrates all those people who have died and gone through their purification (either in this world or in Purgatory) and are in the Presence of the Lord.

All Souls Day Saturday, 02 November. Souls in Purgatory are called "Poor and Suffering"... There is hope for them because Purgatory, unlike Hell, is not permanent and eventually all those in Purgatory will end up in Heaven.
