Advent Reflections with Archbishop Mulhall: Wednesdays, beginning Dec 11; 7:00 pm, St. Mary's Cathedral (279 Johnson Street, Kingston). Archbishop Mulhall will be giving Advent Reflections beginning the second week of December at St. Mary's Cathedral. We hope you will join us.

Christmas Flowers: Envelopes are available at the back of the Church for your donation to purchase flowers to decorate the sanctuary for Christmas. Included with the envelope will be a card for you to write your intentions. These intentions will be prayed for during the Christmas season. Cost of the decorations at both churches last year was \$272.43, we received \$160 so a cost to the parish of \$112.43.



Christmas Exchange Food Drive: We are not putting out a box this year, but those who wish to help out can drop off a financial donation in the collection basket and we will get it to the organizers (make cheque to South Dundas Christmas Exchange). Also, there are angel trees in Morrisburg and Iroquois.

Heating Issue at St. Cecilia's Church: After research from Atel Air they found that the sump pump had failed and the water enter the ductworks. The ducts lines are like a weeping tile and appear to be made out of hard carboard and covered with concrete. Enviroplus was hired to clean up the lines and inspect the ductworks. Their finding was that the water from the failed sump pump damaged the tiled so much that they collapsed. Efforts were made to unplug the lines and some debris was recovered. However, the tile had hardened and they could not unplug the balance of the ductworks. The finance committee approached a couple contractors to give us quotes and recommendations. We were given 3 options: remove part of the floor; installing electric base board heater or installing a heat pumps system. After discussion the decision was made to go with installing heat pumps.

This was completed this week at a cost of \$10,850 plus HST. Those parishioners who wish to donated towards this expensive repair which wasn't in our budget for this year would be appreciated and will be added to your tax receipt. Please place in the collection basket with a note to go toward the heating at St. Cecilia's. Thank you.
