All Souls Day Remembrance: We will remember and pray for all our dear deceased ones from the parish and our families on all souls day and throughout November. We will have a Mass offered for them and a candle lit by a family member for those passed away in the current year. In 2025 it will be on Sunday November 2, at 9 am for those deceased from November 2, 2024 to November 1, 2025. The names of the deceased are taken from the parish register. We have no access to the record of the people who had no Catholic funeral/burial even if they are a long-time parishioner. Friends, when you prepare your wills, please make sure that you will get a Catholic funeral/burial or a least a grave side prayer and blessing of the grave. If a cemetery undertaker or care taker is doing the burial, it will not be in the parish record. It's applicable not only for us, but for all the parishes of the Archdiocese.

Priests' Benefit Fund 9 November, the annual collection for retired and disabled priests will be taken at Mass. Please be generous. Last's year's collection received approximately \$200,000, our parish contributed \$2,496, and we are grateful, but the expenses of the Fund continue to rise. Thank you for caring for those who always cared for us.

Cemetery Collection: November 16 will be the annual collection for St. Mary's and St. Anne's Cemeteries. We are very grateful to parishioners for their donations as this helps our Catholic Cemeteries with the upkeep. Please mark on the envelope which Cemetery you wish your donation to help. Those that aren't marked will be divided equally between St. Mary's Cemetery and St. Anne's Cemetery.



Roof Replacement: On September 25th, the finance committee chair, Terry O'Reilly met with the Archdiocese for approval for the replacement of the flat roof at St. Mary's (this includes the rectory, garage, and church plus the sky lights). There were four tenders received and the winning company will be Wolfenburg and the start date will be **Nov 17/19**. The

cost will be \$120,000 plus HST. The parish has \$55,000 invested with the Diocese and will be using that amount plus a loan from the Central Development Fund that the Diocese oversees in the amount of \$75,000. There will be special envelopes in the church for donations towards the roof replacement. There will be more information regarding Mass times once Father Oliver is back.
